

US FDA warns DRL of import ban

Hyderabad: The United States Food and Drug Administration (USFDA) has warned homegrown pharma major Dr Reddy's Laboratories (DRL) that if the company fails to take corrective actions at three of its manufacturing facilities—Srikakulam, Miryalaguda and Duvvada—it may lead to imposition of import ban on these units.

The details of the letter dated November 5, 2015 were made available on the USFDA website on Tuesday.

The US drug regulator had issued a warning letter after DRL was not able to convince it about the corrective measures it planned to take at its three units. TNN

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
