Subject:- Modification in guidelines of the sub-scheme “Revamped Pharmaceutical Technology Upgradation Assistance Scheme (RPTUAS), a sub-scheme of the umbrella scheme “Strengthening of Pharmaceutical Industry (SPI)”

Department of Pharmaceuticals, Government of India has notified the guidelines for the scheme “Strengthening of Pharmaceutical Industry” (SPI) vide Notification No. G-30015/25/2021-Scheme dated 11th March, 2022 with subsequent modifications issued vide corrigenda of even numbers 07.07.2022, 12.01.2023, 11.03.2024 and 17.09.2024 modifying certain clauses of Revised Pharmaceutical Technology Upgradation Assistance Scheme (RPTUAS).

2. Pursuant to deliberations, the Scheme Steering Committee (SSC) for the Scheme “Strengthening of Pharmaceutical Industry” (SPI) has recommended to further liberalise the modalities of implementation of the sub-scheme-RPTUAS. Based on the recommendation of the SSC and with the approval of competent authority, the following modifications in the guidelines of the sub-scheme RPTUAS are hereby notified: -

1.	8.2.5 (4)	To claim 1 st instalment of subsidy, the short-listed applicant should submit the requisite Revised Schedule M certificate and CA certified expenditure incurred after 01.01.2024 on eligible activities under the scheme.	To claim 1 st instalment of subsidy/incentive, the shortlisted applicant will require to submit any one of the certificates i.e. Revised Schedule M or WHO-GMP certificate with CA certified expenditure incurred after 01.01.2024 on eligible activities under the scheme.
	8.2.5 (7)	The shortlisted applicant should subsequently submit the requisite WHO-GMP certificate and CA certified expenditure incurred after 01.01.2024 on eligible activities under the scheme.	The shortlisted applicant should subsequently submit the remaining one certificate i.e. Revised Schedule M or WHO-GMP certificate with CA certified expenditure incurred after 01.01.2024 on eligible activities under the scheme, at the time of the claim of 2 nd instalment.

This is in supersession of the existing provisions in the guidelines of the sub-scheme RPTUAS issued vide notification of even number dated 11.03.2022 and subsequent corrigenda of even number dated 07.07.2022, 12.01.2023, 11.03.2024 and 17.09.2024. All other provisions as contained in the scheme SPI guidelines dated 14.03.2024 will be remain unchanged.
