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### **Lupin gests USFDA nod for diarrhoea drug**

**MUMBAI:** Lupin, on Monday, said it had received the final approval from the United States Food and Drugs Administration (FDA) to market a generic version of ANI Pharmaceuticals' Vancocin capsules of 125 mg and 250 mg strengths. The product is used to treat C.difficile-associated diarrhea and enterocolitis caused by Staphylococcus aureus (including methicillin-resistant strains). Vancocin capsules had annual U.S. sales of \$164.2 million (IMS September, 2014). Lupin's U.S. subsidiary Lupin Pharmaceuticals Inc. will commence marketing the product shortly. — Special Correspondent

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
