Shantha's new unit to make Insuman

Hyderabad: Shantha Biotechnics Pvt. Ltd on Thursday began building a facility to manufacture Insuman, an insulin product to treat diabetes. French pharmaceutical company, Sanofi SA, which acquired Shantha Biotechnics in 2009 through its vaccines division, Sanofi Pasteur SA, is investing ₹460 crore to build the facility that, at full capacity, will produce 60 million cartridges of Insuman annually, company executives said.
