Two held for fake injection dealings ٠

· NEW DELHI: Two persons were arrested for supplying

• spurious injections of Buprenorphine Hydrochloride, a controlled synthetic drug, commonly known as Norphene,

police said on Saturday. Sunil Sharma (37), was arrested from Mayur Vihar in East Delhi while Naresh Kumar Chhikara (53), was held in Haryana in August. Sharma owns a go-down near Mayur Vihar Phase-I, where a total of 1,40,000 ampoules of spurious injections of Norphene were recovered. "Sharma used to get these injections manufactured at a unit being run by Chhikara in Haryana. Chhikara was arrested later, Joint Commissioner of Police (Crime Branch) Ravindra Yadav said. Police said that Norphene is used in cancer treatment and at de-addiction centres but is widely PTI wmisused by drug addicts.
