## Government fixes prices of 33 essential drugs

## **PRESS TRUST OF INDIA** New Delhi, 25 January

he government has capped prices of 11 essential drugs while those of 22 such medicines have been revised, including those used for treatment of cancer, HIV, bacterial infections and acid reflux, among others.

"National Pharmaceutical Pricing Authority has fixed/revised ceiling prices of 33 scheduled formulations of Schedule-I under Drugs (Price Control) Amendment Order, 2017, in related notification/order dated January 24," NPPA said.

The ceiling prices of 11 scheduled formulations have been notified while ceiling prices of 22 scheduled formulations have been revised, it added.

As stipulated under the Drugs (Prices Control) Order (DPCO), 2013, NPPA fixes ceiling prices of essential medicines of Schedule-I.

Set up in 1997, NPPA has been entrusted with the task of fixation/revision of prices of pharma products, enforcement of provisions of DPCO, and monitoring of prices of controlled and decontrolled drugs.
