### Three Wockhardt insulin drugs exempted

NEW DELHI: Drug price regulator National Pharmaceutical Pricing Authority has exempted Wockhardt's three insulin products from price controls for a period of five years with effect from January 8 this year. The Mumbai-based drug firm had applied to the National Pharmaceutical Pricing Authority (NPPA) for non-application of price control provisions of the DPCO 2013 on the three drugs. The three products that have exempted for a period of five years are: Insulin Human Injection, 200IU/ml, Isophane Insulin Human Suspension, 200IU/ml and 70 per cent Isophane Insulin Human Suspension and 30 per cent Insulin Human Injection, 200IU/ml, the statement said. The exemption on the three products would be with effect from January 8, 2015, which is the date of grant of marketing approval by the Drugs Controller General (India), it added. — PTI

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
