## Pharma institutes ink 17 agreements with corporates

To boost innovation, seven National Institutes for Pharmaceutical Education and Research (NIPERs) have signed linkage agreements with 17 public and private companies.

The memoranda of understanding (MoUs) were exchanged in the presence of President Pranab Mukherjee on November 4, according to an official statement.

"The Department of Pharmaceuticals has identified academia-industry linkage as a basic requirement for translating research into development (commercialisation) and innovation, and also to fix accountability among the educational institutions," the statement said. MoUs for formulation development were also signed between NIPER Mohali and Sun Pharma and Medley Pharma, for R&D in anti-inflammatory and lifestyle disease segments with Wockhardt, and for collaborative research in metabolic disorders, oncology etc, with Panacea Biotech.
