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DCGI restores EU export licence to Ranbaxy's unit

In the wake of the European Medicines Agency's June order restoring Ranbaxy Laboratories Ltd's good manufacturing practices certification on its Toansa unit in Punjab, the Central Drugs Standard Control Organisation has now reinstated the company's licence that allows it to resume supplies to the European Union, a government official said.

The Drug Controller General of India had in May suspended Ranbaxy's supplies from Toansa to the European Union citing non-compliance of set standards.

All of Ranbaxy plants--Toansa, Paonta Sahib, Mohali and Dewas--are under an import alert from the US Food and Drug Administration. -Cogencis
