Wockhardt recalls hypertension drug in U.S.

NEW DELHI: Wockhardt is recalling over 8,000 bottles of anti-hypertension drug Metoprolol Succinate extended-release tablets in the U.S. market following failure of a dissolution test. According to the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (USFDA), Wockhardt USA Inc, a subsidiary of Mumbai-based firm is voluntarily recalling 8,712 bottles of the drug in the American market. The recall is due to the "failure of dissolution test observed at three month time point", the USFDA said. — PTI
