### Cadila sacks 60 at Gujarat plant

Zydus Cadila has dismissed 60 workers at its plant in Moraiya near Ahmedabad for creating unrest at the workplace, said sources. They said 350 workers would remain absent from Thursday. The plant worked as usual on Wednesday. The company did not comment. Police officials said two workers had been arrested for assaulting the supervisor on Tuesday during a protest against a new system of one worker at a machine instead of two earlier. "We were let inside the plant today (on Wednesday) after signing an undertaking that we would work for eight hours and not go outside during the shift. Our mobile phones were also seized by the company. Meanwhile, around 60 workers were called by the management for a meeting. We later learnt (after completing our shift) that these workers were terminated by the company and sent home," claimed a worker. BS REPORTER
