

## Cadila standalone net zooms

Ahmedabad, February 7

Ahmedabad-based drug-maker Cadila Healthcare Ltd reported a 297 per cent jump in standalone net profit for the December quarter at ₹195 crore compared with ₹49 crore in the year-ago period.

Net income increased 24 per cent to ₹897 crore (₹724 crore). On a consolidated basis, the company's net profit jumped 82 per cent to ₹186 crore (₹102 crore).

Consolidated net sales for the quarter stood at ₹1,838 crore (₹1,561 crore).

"During the quarter, the company's business in the US registered a growth of 61 per cent and emerging markets business grew 30 per cent," Cadila said.

It filed 31 additional abbreviated new drug applications (ANDAs) with the US Food and Drug Administration (FDA), taking the cumulative ANDA filings for the period to 49. During the quarter, it launched several new products in the international market.
