

DRL RECALLS 58K CONTAMINATED BOTTLES OF DRUG

New Delhi, March 13: Dr Reddy's Laboratories has recalled 58,656 bottles of its heartburn drug Lansoprazole in the United States due to a microbial contamination.

The US Food and Drug Administration has classified the recall of the drug as 'Class II' which indicates a remote chance of severe adverse consequences or death due to the product flaw.

The USFDA has been cracking down heavily on Indian drug makers for non-compliance of manufacturing norms.

DRL shares today closed at ₹2,734.15 on the BSE, up 1.63 per cent from its previous close. — PTI
