TB drug treatment enters Phase II trials

New Delhi: The Council of Scientific and Industrial Research's open source drug discovery (OSDD) project on Monday handed over a new drug combination to the Lala Ram Sarup TB Hospital in New Delhi to take it forward for so-called Phase Ilb clinical trials to study the efficacy of the drug that will target multidrug resistant tuberculosis in Indian patients. The treatment, PaMZ, was originally developed by the Global Alliance for TB Drug Development, but OSDD now has the rights for it.
