## PHARMA EXPORTS UP 10.5% IN APRIL

New Delhi, 12 May: India's pharmaceutical exports grew 10.5 per cent, year-on-year, to \$1.26 billion in April, according to the commerce ministry data. "This year we are expecting a healthy rate of growth in pharma exports. Reg s such as Africa will help in enhancing exports," said an official.

Pharma exports registered slowest growth in at least 15 years at 1.2 per cent to \$14.84 billion in the 2013-14 fiscal amid growing tension with the USA over intellectual property rights related issues. "2013-14 has seen slowdown in growth because of the USA raising concerns and due to increase in global competition," Pharmaceuticals Export Promotion Council (Pharmexcil) executive director PV Appaji said.
