F. No. 204/OR/A & E/1132.—In pursuance of Sections 23 and 29 of the National Institute of Pharmaceutical Education and Research Act, 1998 (13 of 1998), the Senate of the National Institute of Pharmaceutical Education and Research hereby makes the following amendments in the Ordinance 13 and 14, regulating the scholarships and Registration of Student of the Institute relating to the Degree of Masters' and Doctor of Philosophy and directs that the said amendments in the Ordinance shall come into force wish effect from the date of its publication, namely :—

Amendment of Section 13(4) approved in 54th Meeting of BOG held on 2nd August, 2011.—"The scholarship will be liable to termination at any stage, if the progress of work and the conduct of the award are not found satisfactory." is amended to

"The scholarship will be liable to be terminated at any stage, if the progress of work and the conduct of the awardee are not found satisfactory. However, student will be given an opportunity to be heard before any adverse action is initiated agaist him/her."

Amendment of Section 14(12) approved in 54th Meeting of BOG held on 2nd August, 2011.—The registration of the student will stand cancelled under any one of the following circumstances :---

- (i) if the student remained absent for a continuous period of four weeks without prior intimation or sanction of the leave;
- (ii) if the student resigns from the programme and the resignation is duly recommended by the Student Research Committee (SRC);
- (iii) if the student fails to register for any semester;
- (iv) if the academic performance of the student is found unsatisfactory;
- (v) if the student does not clear the examinations;
- (vi) if the student is found to be involved in an act of misconduct and/or indiscipline and termination is recommended by a competent authority.

However, student will be given an opportunity to be heard before any adverse action as at 14(12) (i), (iv) and (vi) is initiated against him/her.
