

Aurobindo gets USFDA nod for 3 generic injections

NEW DELHI: Drug firm Aurobindo Pharma on Friday said it has received final approvals from the US health regulator to sell multiple strengths of its generic Ampicillin and Sulbactam for injections. The company said the US Food and Drug Administration (USFDA) has approved its three Abbreviated New Drug Applications (ANDA) for Ampicillin and Sulbactam antibiotic injections, that are used for treatment of skin infections, abdominal and gynecological infections. "The product has a market size of approximately \$50 million according to IMS as of June 2009 and is ready for launch," the company said.

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
